**Organic Chemistry I and II  
Lecture for Chemistry Majors**  
(CHEM 3201 / 3211)

Required for chemistry majors. Biochemistry, biology, and HPNU majors may opt to take this course.

**Organic Chemistry I and II  
Lab for Chemistry Majors**  
(CHEM 3203 / 3213)

Required for chemistry majors. Biochemistry, biology, and HPNU majors may opt to take this course. Lab is 2 credits and meets for 6 hours per week.

**Organic Chemistry I and II  
Lecture**  
(CHEM 3101 / 3111)

This course is typically taken by biochemistry, biology, and HPNU majors.

**Organic Chemistry I and II  
Lab for Biochemistry Majors**  
(CHEM 3103 / 3113):

Required for biochemistry majors. Biology and HPNU majors may opt to take this course. All labs are in-person.

**Organic Chemistry I and II  
Lab**  
(CHEM 3102 / 3112)

This course is typically taken by biology and HPNU majors.

**Organic Chemistry Lecture**  
(CHEM 3001)

A condensed survey course, appropriate only for Health Care Science – Medical Lab Science majors.

**Organic Chemistry Lab**  
(CHEM 3002)

A condensed lab, appropriate only for Health Care Science - Medical Lab Science majors.
